### Harbour fees

- If you intend to sail a boat from the Club slipway, whether it is parked at the Club or not, you must pay Harbour Dues to the Club.
- Canoes do not pay Harbour Fees.
- Boats on moorings must pay Harbour Fees at the Harbour Master's Office.

### Boat parking

- WSC Boat Stickers are issued annually on receipt of boat parking fees.
- Only boats/canoes displaying a valid sticker may be parked on WSC land.
- Allocation of boat parking spaces is at the discretion of the Sailing Secretary, and will be displayed in the Clubhouse.
- Charges made for boat parking during the winter period (1 November to 31 March) are in addition to summer charges and are at the same rate.
