Harbour Dues

- If you intend to sail a boat from the Club slipway, whether it is parked at the Club or not, you must pay Harbour Dues to the Club.
- Canoes do not pay Harbour Dues.

Boat parking

- WSC boat/canoe stickers are issued annually on receipt of fees.
- Only boats/canoes displaying a valid sticker may be parked on WSC land.
- Allocation of boat/canoe parking spaces is at the discretion of the Sailing Secretary.
- Wells Sailing Club does not offer boat parking during the winter period (1 November to 31 March).
- Canoe storage is for one calendar year and is at a premium. Members can only add their name to the waiting list once they have officially joined the club.
